

Tresco Island Canine Contract

We love dogs, and many of us have our own faithful hounds. We've put together our Canine Contract below to allow everyone – humans, furry friends and other animals – to coexist harmoniously and maintain the island's peaceful agricultural and natural environment.

Our Accommodation

Generally, our accommodation is dog-free, so dogs cannot stay overnight on Tresco (except during our dog-friendly breaks – see below). Our sister hotel on Bryher, [Hell Bay Hotel](#), is dog-friendly all season.

Around the Island

Dogs are most welcome on Tresco for day visits, but we do ask that our four-legged friends (and their owners) adhere to the following rules:

- Dogs must be kept on leads in all public areas of Tresco except the areas outlined below.
- Provided your dog has good recall and is kept within sight, they may go off the lead only in the following areas:
 - The north end – a line from New Grimsby Quay to Gimble Porth
 - The south – A line from Tresco Heliport to Tobaccoman's Point
 - Appletree Bay, Bathinghouse Porth and Pentle Bay
- At certain times of year, additional restrictions may be in place, so all signage must be adhered to.
- At The New Inn, dogs are welcome in the Bar and on the terrace but not in the Pavilion or any accommodation areas (including the Sleeper's Sitting Room).
- At The Ruin Beach Café, Garden Café and Flying Boat Café, dogs are welcome on the terrace but not inside.
- In Tresco Abbey Garden, dogs are welcome on a short lead throughout the garden.
- Dogs are not permitted in Tresco Stores, Lucy-Tania Boutique, or any of our Spa facilities.
- Please clean up after your dog. Bagged waste can be disposed of in any outside general waste bin.
- Please be mindful of other guests and ensure your dog always remains under close control, quiet and not causing a nuisance to others.

Dog-Friendly Stays

Occasionally, we're delighted to welcome four-legged friends for longer stays on Tresco with our dog-friendly breaks. If you're staying with your dog, please follow the rules below:

- We welcome well-behaved dogs, and up to two are welcome to join us during our dog-friendly stay periods, booked in advance
- On arrival, you'll find a pack containing bowls, towels and maybe a treat.
- Please thoroughly clean coats and paws before coming inside. Where possible, please keep dogs in hard-floored areas of your cottage until they are thoroughly clean and dry.
- Your dog must not be left unaccompanied in our accommodation at any time.
- Your dog must not be allowed on furniture, particularly sofas and beds.
- Dogs must not go upstairs in accommodation. Stairs have child gates to assist with this.

The Claws Clause

Please note that an additional cleaning fee of up to £200 may be charged if your accommodation is damaged, left in a poor condition or the above rules are not followed.
